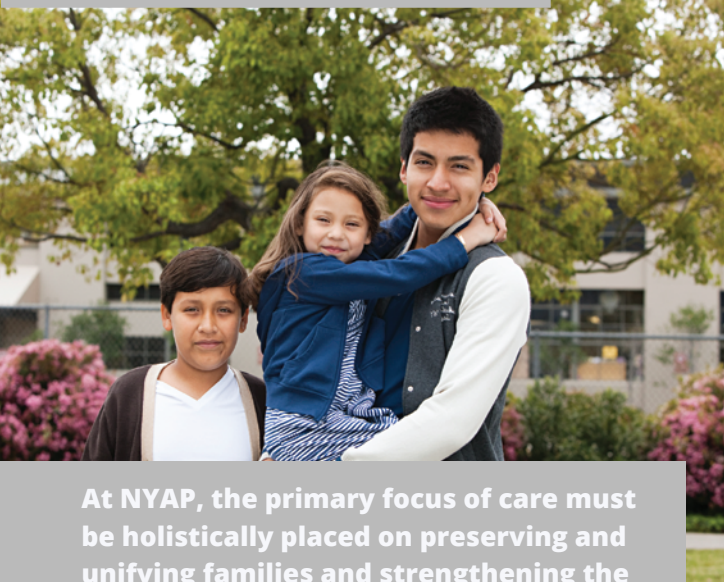


WHO WE ARE

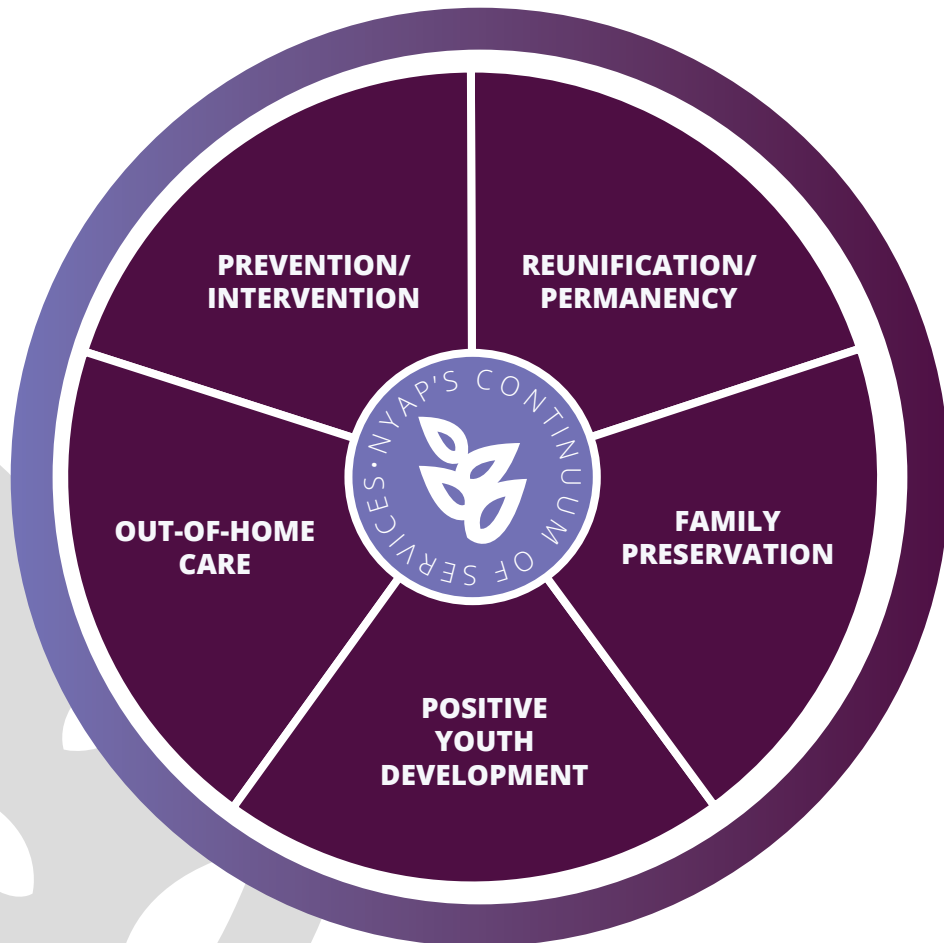

24/7 SERVICE RECEPTION

NYAP's Service Reception serves as a single point of contact for all inquiries accepting referrals, answering questions and providing support .

PREVENTION/INTERVENTION

Providing services to help individuals through a variety of models and programs including AOD, behavioral health and more.

REUNIFICATION/PERMANENCY

Developing the capacities of biological, adoptive and kinship caregivers in order to improve the likelihood of permanency for youth and supporting family reunification.

FAMILY PRESERVATION

Empowering families to live safely, successfully and unified in their home communities. Services include both diversion and reunification programs.

POSITIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

Offering a variety of positive youth and family development programs to promote community involvement and positive family relations.

OUT-OF-HOME PLACEMENT

Ensuring youth are in a safe and resourceful environment, ultimately helping those who cannot live at home reunite with family or someone they know.
